


Wedding Preparation

3-8 MONTHS UNTIL "I-DO"



- Purchase wedding bands
- Choose bridal & bridesmaid accessories
- Create a wedding registry at a minimum of three retailers for gifts
- Apply for a passport if you're honeymooning outside of the country
- Create a honeymoon itinerary for family at home
- Shop with mothers for Mother-Of attire
- Have food tasting with the caterer and finalize the menu
- Meet with Officiant to discuss plans for ceremony
- Purchase additional day-of stationery (menus, place cards, programs, etc.)
- Finalize attire and fittings for wedding party and parents
- Finalize playlists with DJ/Band/Musicians
- Finalize reception menu & order menu cards
- Purchase gifts for bridal party and out-of-town guests




0-3 MONTHS UNTIL "I-DO"

- Purchase postage & mail wedding invitations
- Collect and record RSVPs (pg. 4)
- Have a bridal shower
- Apply for your Marriage License (pg. 39)
- Begin writing vows
- Review ceremony details with your Officiant
- Finalize wedding day timeline with your Wedding Planner, Photographer, and venue (pg. 38)
- Determine your "Something Old, New, Borrowed, and Blue" items
- Plan ceremony and reception seating arrangements
- Send rehearsal dinner invitations

Two Weeks until "I-Do"

- Follow up with guests who have not RSVP'd
- Give a final guest count to caterer
- Review wedding day details with your wedding planner
- Update your registries
- Begin breaking-in wedding shows
- Have a final dress fitting
- Make arrangements for the caring of pets and plants while on your honeymoon
- Have one final haircut and color before your big day
- Delegate wedding day duties (i.e. ushering, guest book, gift table, etc.)
- Delegate someone to return tuxes, rentals, and tend to your dress
- Provide directions for wedding day transportation
- Discuss who will be distributing tips
